## **HOW TO ACCESS LAMBTON COUNTY LIBRARY DATABASES FROM HOME**

1. Go to the Libraries, Museums and Galleries home page at [www.lclmg.org](http://www.lclmg.org).
2. Refer to the menu on the left side of the screen.
3. Place the cursor on the "@ Your Library" button.
4. Select "Electronic Databases" from the side bar menu.
5. Browse categories at the top of the Electronic Databases box and click on a database you wish to search.
6. For remote access, type your 14-digit library card number. Note: You may be required to enter a username and password. To obtain these please contact your local library.
7. For InfoTrac databases, a complete list appears. Select the database of your choice.
8. Refer to the Search Tips menu for assistance.
9. Information from the databases may be printed or sent by email.
10. Online help is available for each of these databases.
